



This year, the DZIF course „Clinical Tuberculosis“ will take place from June 24th to 26th at the Research Center Borstel, Leibniz Lung Center, in Borstel, Germany.

This course provides a comprehensive update on the clinical management of tuberculosis, alongside the latest advances in cutting-edge research. In addition to a keynote lecture Professor Hu will conduct a satellite symposium on “New tools for the diagnosis of tuberculosis” with a limited number of interested fellows.
